During his service with the government he held senior positions in the last 20 years and had vast experience in human resource management; inspectorate and management services and overall security matters. Mr. Pang holds a diploma in Criminal Justice and attended a one-year programme in Public Administration in University of California at Berkeley and the Strategic Management Programme in Ashridge Business School in London. He was promoted to the rank of Deputy Commissioner in 2000 and Commissioner of Correctional Services in 2003. Mr. Pang retired from the civil service in July 2006. 1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 323,649,123 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the relevant ordinary resolution at the Annual General Meeting to approve the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase Shares and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the Annual General Meeting, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 32,364,912 Shares, representing approximately 10% of the issued share capital of the Company as at the Latest Practicable Date.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders to have a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Directors to repurchase Shares on the market.
